

The Carlton Millrace Kids Club

Welcome to the Carlton Millrace Leisure Club, here we offer you and your children a chance to make the most of your stay with us. We offer a range of activities and games which are guaranteed to keep your children entertained for hours. Swimming, pool games, arts and crafts and fun games are just a few.

The Carlton Crazy Club begins at 9.00am for the Breakfast train. Children are collected from their room and go for breakfast all together in the kid's club room. (No hot food will be served for breakfast)

We have kids dinners first then followed by all the cool and crazy games like colour competition, fun with balloons, arts & crafts, make and bake, karaoke, disco's and lots more. Finally when all the kids are tired we all sit down for the kiddie's movie with popcorn and juice. There is a different movie every night.

Club Rules & Regulations

1. Parents must sign their children in and out when entering and leaving the club. You must give full details on our sign in /sign out sheet, giving name, number of children, room number. Under no circumstances will children be able allowed to leave unless they have permission.
2. Children must wear appropriate clothing when participating in games and activities in the kids club. They must wear comfortable clothing; jewellery must be removed before kids club begins.
3. No food or drinks are allowed when participating in activities, especially chewing gum.
4. Bad behaviour will not be tolerated; this includes bad language and abuse of any kind towards the leaders or fellow participants.
5. All staff must be notified if a child has any medical conditions or illnesses.
6. All club rules and regulations apply. For example children must have swim hats when entering the pool.
7. Parents must ensure that swim gear is ready for all kids at 9.00am
